

What is the Phoenix Group?

The Phoenix Post Diagnosis Group Ltd is a registered Charity, No; 1115832, dedicated to the provision of respite and fellowship for sufferers of any form of dementia and, importantly, their carers.

What are the charity's aims?

- To enable people with dementia to enjoy the company of others in the same situation.
- To enable carers to discuss problems and share experiences with other carers, and former carers who have lost their loved ones. To provide a friendly social atmosphere where friendships are often made thus providing a lasting supportive network for the future. To provide activities and entertainment such as coach trips, singers and talks from Age uk and the Alzheimers Society.

Who is eligible?

People living in North Warwickshire, or local communities, with dementia and their carers, in most cases husbands and wives but can be anyone who gives substantial care.

Each couple needs to be self caring as we are not professional health workers.

If you are a carer you can attend without the person you care for as the charity is for carers as well as people with dementia.

The charity also welcomes former carers who have lost their loved ones to dementia.



Where does the Group meet?

The Group meets every Tuesday 11.00 to 3.00 at

Wood End Working Mens Club. (address on rear)
